The FEL(s) is the emission level declared by the manufacturer and serves in lieu of an emission standard for certification purposes in any averaging, banking, or trading (ABT) programs. It will be used for determining compliance of any engine in this family and compliance with such ABT programs.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: Except in vehicle applications exempted per 13 CCR 1956.8(a)(6)(B), engines in this engine family certified under 13 CCR 1956.8(a)(6)(C) [30 g/hr NOx] and section 35.B.4 of the incorporated "California Exhaust Emissions Standards and Test Procedures for 2004 and Subsequent Model Heavy-Duty Diesel Engines and Vehicles" adopted Dec. 12, 2002, as last amended Sep. 1, 2006, shall be provided with an approved "Certified Clean Idle" label that shall be affixed to the vehicle into which the engine is installed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: The listed engine models are conditionally certified pending final approval of "Certified Clean Idle" vehicle label. The manufacturer has until March 1, 2009 to resolve concerns on this conditional certification. This Executive Order is effective through March 1, 2009; engines produced after this date are not covered by this Executive Order unless provided with a "Certified Clean Idle" label approved by ARB. In addition, the engine models listed above are certified on the condition that vehicles into which the conditionally certified engines are installed and to which were affixed a "Certified Clean Idle" label that does not have final ARB approval shall have an ARB approved "Certified Clean Idle" label affixed no later than December 31, 2009.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: The listed engine models have been certified to the split engine family standards under 13 CCR 1956.8(b) [diesel engines] or 13 CCR 1956.8(d) [OTTO engines] and the incorporated 40CFR 86.007-15(m)(9).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: For the listed engine models the manufacturer has submitted the materials to demonstrate certification compliance with 13 CCR 1965 (emission control labels) and 13 CCR 2035 et seq. (emission control warranty).
