The manufacturer has submitted the required information and therefore has met the criteria necessary to receive a California Executive Order based on the Environmental Protection Agency's Certificate of Conformity for the above listed engine family.

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**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:** Certification to the FEL(s) / FCL(s) listed above, as applicable, is subject to the following terms, limitations and conditions. The FEL(s) / FCL(s) is the emission level declared by the manufacturer and serves in lieu of an emission standard for certification purposes in any averaging, banking, or trading (ABT) programs. It will be used for determining compliance of any engine in this family and compliance with such ABT programs.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:** For the listed engine models the manufacturer has submitted the materials to demonstrate certification compliance with 13 CCR 1965 (emission control labels), 13 CCR 1971.1 (on-board diagnostic, full or partial compliance) and 13 CCR 2035 et seq. (emission control warranty).

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:** The listed engine models are conditionally certified in accordance with 13 CCR Section 1971.1(k) (deficiency and fines provisions for certification of malfunction and diagnostic system) because the heavy-duty on-board diagnostic (HD OBD) system of the listed engine models has been determined to have sixteen deficiencies. The listed engine models are approved subject to the manufacturer paying a fine of \$500 per engine for the third through sixteenth deficiencies in the listed engine family that is produced and delivered for sale in California. On a quarterly basis, the manufacturer shall submit to California Air Resources Board reports of the number of engines produced and delivered for sale in California and pay the full fine owed for that quarter pursuant to this conditional certification. Payment shall be made payable to the State Treasurer for deposit in the Air Pollution Control Fund no later than thirty (30) days after the end of each calendar quarter during the 2018 model-year production period. Failure to pay the quarterly fine, in full, in the time provided, may be cause for the Executive Officer to rescind this conditional certification, effective from the start of the quarter in question, in which case all engines covered under this conditional certification for that quarter and all future quarters would be deemed uncertified and subject to a civil penalty of up to \$5000 per engine pursuant to HSC Section 43154.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:** The Cummins hybrid engine ratings listed on this Executive Order may only be used with new on-road Allison hybrid system models hybrid system models and BAE hybrid system models whose on-board diagnostic system have been approved as compatible.

Engines certified under this Executive Order must conform to all applicable California emission regulations.

The Bureau of Automotive Repair will be notified by copy of this Executive Order.

This Executive Order hereby supersedes Executive Order A-021-0686-1 dated January 24, 2018.
