Relating to Certification of New Motor Vehicles

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Air Resources Board by Sections 39018, 39600, 39601, and 43101, and 43102 of the Health and Safety Code; and

Pursuant to the authority vested in the undersigned by Section 39515 and 39516 of the Health and Safety Code and Executive Order G-45-3;

IT IS ORDERED AND RESOLVED: That Apollo Motor Homes Inc. heavy-duty vehicles are approved using the 1976 gasoline engines listed below:



Section 43200, Part I, Division 26 of the California Health and Safety Code requires that a decal be affixed to the side window to the rear of the driver or, if there is no such window on the driver's side, to the windshield of the motor vehicle. This decal discloses the highest emissions from the certification fleet for that vehicle for which certification has been granted by the Board.

The recommended emission values are listed above.
