EXECUTIVE ORDER A-330-36

Relating to Certification of New Medium-Duty Motor Vehicles

BAYTECH CORPORATION

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Air Resources Board by Sections 43100, 43102 and 43103 of the Health and Safety Code; and

Pursuant to the authority vested in the undersigned by Sections 39515 and 39516 of the Health and Safety Code and Executive Order G-45-9;

IT IS ORDERED AND RESOLVED: That 2001 model-year Baytech Corporation motor vehicles which have a manufacturer's gross vehicle weight rating (GVWR) from 8,501 to 14,000 pounds are certified using Otto-cycle engines listed below:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the listed vehicle models shall be subject to the in-use compliance provisions applicable to 1995 and subsequent model-year medium-duty vehicle engines set forth in Title 13, California Code of Regulations, Section 2139(c).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the listed vehicle models also comply with the "Malfunction and Diagnostic System Requirements--1994 and Subsequent Model-Year Passenger Cars, Light-Duty Trucks, and Medium-Duty Vehicles and Engines" (Title 13, California Code of Regulations, Section 1968.1).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That for the listed vehicle models, the manufacturer has submitted the materials to demonstrate certification compliance with the Board's emission control system warranty provisions (Title 13, California Code of Regulations, Section 2035 et seq.).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the listed vehicle models comply with the "California Motor Vehicle Emission Control and Smog Index Label Specifications" for the aforementioned model year (Title 13, California Code of Regulations, Section 1965).

Vehicles certified under this Executive Order must conform to all applicable California emission regulations.

The Bureau of Automotive Repair will be notified by copy of this order and attachments.
