BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: The listed engine models have been certified to the optional emission standards and test procedures in 13 CCR 1956.8 applicable to diesel or incomplete MDV with a 8501-14000 pound GVWR and shall be subject to 13 CCR 2139(c) (in-use testing of engines certified for use in diesel or incomplete MDV with a 8501-14000 pound GVWR).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: For the listed vehicle models the manufacturer has submitted the materials to demonstrate certification compliance with 13 CCR 1965 (emission control labels), 13 CCR 1968.2 (on-board diagnostic, full or partial compliance), 13 CCR 1976(b)(1)(F) {evaporative emission standards}, 13 CCR 2035 et seq. (emission control warranty), and 13 CCR 2235 [fill pipes and openings of motor vehicle fuel tanks]. (The braces {} are for gasoline, LPG or alcohol fueled vehicles only.)

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Vehicles certified under this Executive Order shall conform to all applicable California emission regulations.

The Bureau of Automotive Repair will be notified by copy of this Executive Order.

This Executive Order hereby supersedes Executive Order A-330-0235 dated August 27, 2012.
