BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: The listed engine family is conditionally certified based on the manufacturer providing data to demonstrate the vehicles using these engines comply with the Otto-cycle fleet average emission standard specified in Title 17 CCR 85336(b)(B) and the incorporated "California Greenhouse Gas Exhaust Standards and Test Procedures for 2014 and Subsequent Model Heavy-Duty Vehicles" (HDV Test Procedures) adopted October 21, 2014, as last amended September 9, 2021 within 90 days after the end of the model year.
