EXECUTIVE ORDER N-85-17
Relating to Certification of New Motor Vehicles

FEDERAL MOTORS, INC.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Air Resources Board by Sections 43100 and 43102 of the Health and Safety Code and Title 13, California Administrative Code, Section 1956.7; and

Pursuant to the authority vested in the undersigned by Sections 39515 and 39516 of the Health and Safety Code and Executive Orders G-45-3 and G-45-4;

IT IS ORDERED AND RESOLVED: That 1985 model-year Federal Motors, Inc. motor vehicles which have a manufacturer's gross vehicle weight rating greater than 8500 pounds are certified using the diesel engines listed below:


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Executive Officer has been provided all material required to demonstrate certification compliance with the applicable federal emission control system warranty regulations pursuant to Section 207 of the Clean Air Act.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That this certification is limited to 17 vehicles.
