Relating to Certification of New Heavy-Duty Off-Road Equipment Engines

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Air Resources Board by Sections 43000.5, 43013 and 43018 of the Health and Safety Code; and

Pursuant to the authority vested in the undersigned by Sections 39515 and 39516 of the Health and Safety Code and Executive Order G-45-9;

IT IS ORDERED AND RESOLVED: That the following Case Corporation 1998 model-year engine, with rated power between 175 and 750 horsepower, and exhaust emission control systems are certified as described below for use in heavy-duty off-road equipment:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That for the listed engine models, the manufacturer has submitted the materials to demonstrate certification compliance with the Board's emission control system warranty provisions (Title 13, California Code of Regulations, Section 2425 et seq.).

Engines certified under this Executive Order must conform to all applicable California emission regulations.
