EXECUTIVE ORDER A-7-2
Relating to Approval of New Motor Vehicles

VOLKSWAGEN OF AMERICA, INC.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Air Resources Board by Sections 39150 and 39151 of the Health and Safety Code; and

Pursuant to the authority vested in the undersigned by Section 39023 of the Health and Safety Code;

IT IS ORDERED AND RESOLVED: That Volkswagen of America, Inc. exhaust emission control systems for the additional 1973 model-year light-duty motor vehicle is approved for the engine family described below:

<u>Engine Family</u>	<u>Engine Size (Cubic Inches)</u>	<u>Emission Control System</u>	<u>Vehicle Model</u>
I	96.66	Engine Modification and Exhaust Gas Recirculation	Type 181 VW Thing (Manual Transmission)

Section 39152, Part I, Division 26 of the California Health and Safety Code requires that a decal be affixed to the side window which discloses the highest emissions from the certification fleet for that engine family which approval has been granted by the Board. The exhaust emissions for each vehicle determined by factory assembly-line tests in accordance with the "Assembly-Line Test Procedures for 1973 and Subsequent Model Light-Duty Vehicles" must be shown on a decal.

In accordance with Section III E. of the California Exhaust Emission Standards and Test Procedures for 1973 through 1976 Models Gasoline-Powered Light-Duty Motor Vehicles, the manufacturer is required to inform the Air Resources Board of any production changes which will affect emissions.

Supplemental information sheets are attached to this letter which include tune-up specifications and emission control system data.

The Department of Motor Vehicles, the California Highway Patrol, and the Bureau of Automotive Repair of the Department of Consumer Affairs will be notified of this approval by copy of this order and attachment.
