## EXECUTIVE ORDER A-14-20-1 Relating to Certification of New Motor Vehicles

Pursuant to the authority vested in the undersigned by Health and Safety Code Sections 39515 and 39516 and Executive Orders G-45-3 and G-45-4:

IT IS ORDERED AND RESOLVED: That Toyota Motor Company, Ltd. exhaust emission control systems for 1978 model-year passenger cars are certified for the vehicles described below:

Engine Family: 20R(C)

Engine: 133.6 CID

Transmission: 3-Speed Automatic, 4-Speed Manual, 5-Speed Manual

Exhaust Emission Control System: Air Injection, Exhaust Gas

Recirculation, Oxidation Catalyst.

Models and Engine Codes as listed in attachment.

Executive Order A-14-20 dated September 28, 1977, is hereby rescinded.

The following are the recommended values to be listed on the window decal required by California Assembly-Line Test Procedures for 1978 model-year vehicles:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the above models also comply with the Board's "Specifications for Fill Pipes and Openings of Motor Vehicle Fuel Tanks" (13 California Administrative Code, Section 2290) for the aforementioned model year, or have been granted a temporary exemption from the aforementioned "Specifications" by Executive Order AA-14-1 series.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the above models also comply with "California Evaporative Emission Standards and Test Procedures for 1978 and Subsequent Model Gasoline-powered Motor Vehicles except Motorcycles".
