Pursuant to the authority vested in the Air Resources Board by Sections 43100, 43102, and 43835 of the Health and Safety Code; and

Pursuant to the authority vested in the undersigned by Sections 39515 and 39516 of the Health and Safety Code and Executive Order G-45-3 and G-45-4;

IT IS ORDERED AND RESOLVED: That 1980 model year Dolphin Camper Company light-duty trucks as listed on the attachment are certified using the engine families listed below:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That this certification has been issued upon the condition that no modifications have been made to the primary vehicle manufacturer's exhaust and evaporative emission control systems, and that the window decal required by California Assembly-Line Test Procedures, the unleaded fuel label (if any) and the underhood labels furnished by the primary manufacturer are properly installed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the listed vehicle models also comply with the Board's Specifications for Fill Pipes and Openings of Motor Vehicle Fuel Tanks" (Title 13, California Administrative Code, Section 2290) for the aforementioned model year.
