BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That Ferrari S.p.A. Esercizio Fabbriche Automobili e Corse has provided to the Executive Officer all material required to demonstrate certification compliance with the Board's emission control system warranty regulations (Title 13, California Administrative Code, Section 2036).
