EXECUTIVE ORDER A-292-0066 New Passenger Cars, Light-Duty Trucks and Medium-Duty Vehicles

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Air Resources Board by Health and Safety Code (HSC), Div. 26, Part 5, Chap. 2; and pursuant to the authority vested in the undersigned by HSC Sections 39515-39516 and Executive Order G-02-003;

IT IS ORDERED AND RESOLVED: That the following exhaust and evaporative emission control systems produced by the manufacturer are certified as described below. Production vehicles shall be in all material respects the same as those for which certification is granted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That for the listed vehicle models, the manufacturer has attested to compliance with Title 13, California Code of Regulations, (13 CCR) Sections 1965 [emission control labels], 1968.1 [on-board diagnostic, full or partial compliance], 2035 et seq. [emission control warranty], 2235 [fuel tank fill pipes and openings] (gasoline and alcohol fueled vehicles only), and "High-Altitude Requirements" and "Inspection and Maintenance Emission Standards" (California Exhaust Emission Standards and Test Procedures for 2001 and Subsequent Model PC, LDT and MDV).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the listed vehicle models are permitted intermediate in-use compliance standards pursuant to 13 CCR Section 1961(a)(10). The listed vehicle models are granted a 0.0025 g/mi NMOG credit for all certification and in-use testing pursuant to 13 CCR Section 1961(a)(12) [direct ozone reduction]. The NMOG certification level above reflects application of the 0.0025 g/mi NMOG credit.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the manufacturer has requested that the listed vehicles be conditionally certified as a partial zero emission vehicle (PZEV) and determined to qualify for a baseline PZEV allowance of 0.2 under the amendments to 13 CCR Section 1962(c) that were referenced in the Air Resources Board's Resolution 03-04 adopted by the Board on April 24, 2003 (part of the 2003 Zero Emission Vehicle (ZEV) Amendments). This determination for PZEV qualification is conditional on these amendments being adopted by the Executive Officer and approved by the Office of Administrative Law (OAL), after which they will become effective.

Vehicles certified under this Executive Order shall conform to all applicable California emission regulations. The Bureau of Automotive Repair will be notified by copy of this Executive Order.
