

Executive Order: A-003-0823

New Passenger Cars, Light-Duty Trucks and Medium-Duty Vehicles

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Pursuant to the authority vested in California Air Resources Board by Health and Safety Code (HSC), Division 26, Part 5, Chapter 2; and pursuant to the authority vested in the undersigned by HSC Sections 39515 and 39516 and Executive Order G-19-095;

IT IS ORDERED AND RESOLVED: The following vehicles produced by the manufacturer are certified as plug-in hybrid electric vehicles pursuant to Title 13, California Code of Regulations (13 CCR) Sections 1961 or 1961.2, 1962.2, 1976, 1978 and the incorporated test procedures. Production vehicles shall be in all material respects the same as those for which certification is granted.

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

The exhaust and evaporative emission standards and the certification emission levels for the listed vehicles are as listed on the Attachment. Compliance with the 50° Fahrenheit testing requirement may have been met based on the manufacturer's submitted compliance plan in lieu of testing. Any debit in the manufacturer's fleet average compliance requirement for NMOG+NOx or Vehicle Equivalent Credit (13 CCR Sections 1961.2(b)(1), 1961.2(b)(3), or 1961.2(c) (3), and the incorporated test procedures, as applicable), or Greenhouse Gas Emissions (13 CCR Section 1961.3, or 17 CCR Section 95663, and the incorporated test procedures, as applicable), for PC, LDT, MDPV or MDV shall be equalized as required.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

For the listed vehicle models, the manufacturer has attested to compliance with Title 13, California Code of Regulations, (13 CCR) Sections 1965 [emission control labels], 1968.2 [on-board diagnostic, full or partial compliance], 2035 et seq. [emission control warranty], 2235 [fuel tank fill pipes and openings] (gasoline and alcohol fueled vehicles only), and "High-Altitude Requirements" and "Inspection and Maintenance Emission Standards" (California 2015 and Subsequent Model Criteria Pollutant Exhaust Emission Standards and Test Procedures and 2017 and Subsequent Model Greenhouse Gas Exhaust Emission Standards and Test Procedures for PC, LDT and MDV).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

The vehicle models are conditionally certified in accordance with 13 CCR Section 1968.2(k) (deficiency and fines provisions for certification of malfunction and diagnostic system) because the on-board diagnostic II system of the listed vehicle models has been determined to have nine deficiencies. The listed vehicle models are approved subject to the manufacturer paying a fine of one hundred seventy five dollars (\$175) per vehicle for the third through ninth deficiencies in the listed test group that are produced and delivered for sale in California.

On a quarterly basis, the manufacturer shall submit to the California Air Resources Board reports of the number of vehicles produced and delivered for sale in California and pay the full fine owed for that quarter pursuant to this conditional certification. Payment shall be made payable to the State Treasurer for deposit in the Air Pollution Control Fund no later than thirty (30) days after the end of each calendar quarter during the 2024 model-year production period. Failure to pay the quarterly fine, in full, in the time provided, may be cause for the Executive Officer to rescind this conditional certification, effective from the start of the quarter in question, in which case all vehicles covered under this conditional certification for that quarter and all future quarters would be deemed uncertified and subject to a civil penalty of up to \$45,563 per violation per vehicle pursuant to HSC Section 43154.

Vehicles certified under this Executive Order shall conform to all applicable California emission regulations.

The Bureau of Automotive Repair will be notified by copy of this Executive Order.
