BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the evaporative model emission limit (EMEL), as applicable, is the diurnal emissions level declared by the manufacturer based on diurnal test results for a worst-case engine or equipment model within an evaporative family. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the listed equipment models are conditionally certified based on evaporative emissions results generated using interim evaporative test data.
