REPORTING REQUIREMENTS FOR EMISSION DEFECTS

INFORMATION REPORTS (EDIR) APPLICABLE TO 2005 MODEL YEAR

AND LATER SMALL OFF-ROAD ENGINES

The California Air Resources Board (CARB) requires that manufacturers submit Emission Defect Information Reports (EDIR) according to the California Code of Regulations, Title 13, Sections 2425 and 2425.1 Defects Warranty Requirements for 1996 and Later Off-Road Compression-Ignition Engines and Defect Investigation and Reporting Requirements and Section 2405.1 Emission-Related Defect Reporting Requirements applicable to 2005 model year and later small off-road engines.

These sections (see accompanying attachment) include information warranty requirements, reporting thresholds, corrective action, and reporting requirements.

It has come to the attention of CARB that some manufacturers may not be aware of the required EDIR obligations. Failure to submit EDIRs may result in enforcement action and/or penalties as allowed by law.
