

RE: NOTICE OF PUBLIC AVAILABILITY OF PROPOSED MODIFIED TEXT

PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER ADOPTION OF EMISSION STANDARDS AND TEST PROCEDURES FOR NEW 2003 AND LATER SPARK-IGNITION INBOARD AND STERNDRIVE MARINE ENGINES

The purpose of this correspondence is to announce that the Air Resources Board (ARB or Board) is making available for comment the Board-directed modifications to the amendments to the California regulations for spark-ignition inboard and sterndrive engines, as approved by the Board at the July 26, 2001, public hearing. Written and e-mail comments on the proposed modifications (contained in Attachment B) must be received no later than January 18, 2001, in order to be considered by the Executive Officer prior to final action. On July 26, 2001, the Board approved exhaust emission standards, certification test procedures, compliance provisions, consumer provisions such as environmental labeling, and warranty requirements for 2003 model year and later spark-ignition inboard and sterndrive marine engines. More stringent exhaust emission standards and on-board diagnostic requirements shall be phased-in beginning in 2007, with full implementation by 2009.

This regulatory action was proposed and approved under the authority granted in Health and Safety Code sections 39600, 39601, 43013, 43018, 43101, 43102, and 43104. This action implements, interprets and makes specific Health and Safety Code sections 43013, 43017, 43018, 43101, 43102, 43104, 43105, 43145-43150, 43205.5, and 43210-43212.
