SUBJECT: CARL MOYER PROGRAM ADVISORY GROUP PUBLIC MEETING

The Carl Moyer Memorial Air Quality Standards Attainment Program (Carl Moyer Program) provides incentive grants to reduce emissions from on-road and off-road motor vehicles and equipment. At the Air Resources Board's (ARB or the Board) November 17, 2006 hearing, the ARB adopted revised Carl Moyer Program guidelines to address legislative changes expanding the scope and funding of the Carl Moyer Program. During the meeting, the Board directed staff to convene a Carl Moyer Program Advisory Group to provide input and guidance to ARB on three issues related to the continued, successful implementation of the program. These issues are:

- The definition of surplus emission reductions;
- Fuel neutrality; and
- District administrative funds.

ARB Board Member Supervisor Mark DeSaulnier will lead the Advisory Group. All interested stakeholders are encouraged to participate in the Advisory Group and attend its meetings. A public meeting of the Advisory Group will be held at the following time and location:
