SUBJECT: CALIFORNIA'S FLEET RULE FOR TRANSIT AGENCIES

California's Fleet Rule for Transit Agencies - Transit Fleet Vehicle Requirements, title 13, California Code of Regulations, sections 2020, 2023, 2023.2 and 2023.4, went into effect January 30, 2006. As of January 31, 2006, transit agencies are required to submit a report on its transit fleet vehicles to the Air Resources Board (ARB). The 2006 report forms are available from our website at <a href="http://www.arb.ca.gov/msprog/bus/reportingforms.htm">http://www.arb.ca.gov/msprog/bus/reportingforms.htm</a>.

To assist transit providers with their compliance efforts, ARB staff will conduct eight training seminars on the Fleet Rule for Transit Agencies throughout California. The training seminars are designed to inform transit providers about the Fleet Rule for Transit Agencies, with particular emphasis on the Transit Fleet Vehicle Requirements. The training will provide participants an in depth presentation of the rule, compliance deadlines, detailed examples on how to calculate fleet nitrogen oxide averages and particulate matter baselines to determine compliance, reporting requirements with examples on how to complete reports, and a question and answer period.

Transit agencies that operate, own, or lease vehicles used to meet paratransit, dialaride, commuter, and other public transit needs whether the vehicle is publicly or privately owned or in revenue or non-revenue service should attend this training. This includes private and private non-profit agencies that provide paratransit and dialaride service for public transit agencies. Non-compliance with this Rule is a violation of California law and may result in substantial monetary penalties.
