SUBJECT: In-Use Off-road Diesel Vehicle Workshops

The Air Resources Board (ARB or Board) staff invites you to participate in a series of three public workshops to discuss ARB's proposed In-use Off-road Diesel Vehicle Regulation. The workshops will be held in Riverside, Sacramento and Fresno. The purpose of the workshops will be to discuss revised regulatory language and the expected cost and economic impact of the proposed rule. Revisions are being made to the proposed regulatory language based on input gathered at the most recent set of workshops in December 2006.

The proposed regulation is scheduled to be considered by the Board at a hearing in April 2007. These workshops are scheduled to be the final set before consideration of the regulation by the Board. Previous workshops were held in November 2004, July 2005, January 2006, and December 2006. Staff also held numerous workgroup meetings and informal meetings with interested parties over the past two years.

The purpose of the proposed regulation is to reduce diesel particulate matter and other emissions from in-use off-road diesel-fueled vehicles (25 horsepower and greater engines) operating in California. It would apply to self-propelled vehicles used in construction, mining, airport ground support, and industrial operations. The proposed regulation will not cover equipment used in agricultural operations, portable equipment, military tactical support equipment, or cargo handling equipment used at ports and intermodal rail facilities.
