SUBJECT: PUBLIC WORKSHOP REGARDING PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
THE TRUCK AND BUS REGULATION (REVISED)

The California Air Resources Board (Board) staff invites you to participate in a workshop to discuss proposed amendments to the Truck and Bus regulation. On December 9, 2009, staff presented an update on the impact of the economy on emissions from Trucks and Buses. At that meeting, the Board determined additional flexibility could be provided for fleets adversely affected by the economy, and discussed three alternatives to provide additional flexibility. The Board also identified that the amendments should be focused on smaller businesses and must continue to meet emissions goals and obligations.

At the workshops, staff will present proposed amendments including the three alternatives, and other proposed modifications to the regulation. The workshop dates and times are listed below:
