SUBJECT: CARL MOYER PROGRAM: REVIEW AND UPDATE OF THE COST-EFFECTIVENESS LIMIT AND CAPITAL RECOVERY FACTORS FOR 2012

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This mail-out provides an update to the 2011 Carl Moyer Program Guidelines (Guidelines) as a result of Air Resources Board direction given in Resolution 11-23 to annually update the Guidelines' cost-effectiveness limit and capital recovery factors. An approved revision to the 2011 Guidelines, Appendix G, is now available and is attached for reference. Revisions have been indicated by strikeout/underline.

Effective immediately, the cost-effectiveness limit is updated to \$17,080 and the CRF remains unchanged based on a discount rate of 2 percent. The updated cost-effectiveness limit can be used by air districts for contracts executed beginning April 1, 2012, and must be used for any contracts executed beginning July 1, 2012.
