CARL MOYER PROGRAM: REVIEW AND UPDATE OF THE COST-SUBJECT:

EFFECTIVENESS LIMIT AND CAPITAL RECOVERY FACTORS FOR

2013

This mail-out provides an update to the 2011 Carl Moyer Program Guidelines (Guidelines) as a result of the Air Resources Board direction given in Resolution 11-23 to annually update the Guidelines' cost-effectiveness limit (C/E limit) and capital recovery factors (CRF). An approved revision to the 2011 Guidelines, Appendix G, is now available and is attached for reference. Revisions have been indicated by strikeout/underline.

Effective immediately, the C/E limit is updated to \$17,460 and the CRF is updated to reflect a new discount rate of 1 percent. The updated C/E limit and CRF can be used by air districts for contracts executed beginning April 1, 2013, and must be used for any contracts executed beginning July 1, 2013.
