SUBJECT: CARL MOYER PROGRAM: REVIEW AND UPDATE OF THE COST-EFFECTIVENESS LIMIT AND CAPITAL RECOVERY FACTORS FOR 2014

This mail-out provides an update to the 2011 Carl Moyer Program Guidelines (Guidelines) per the Air Resources Board's direction given in Resolution 11-23 to annually update the Guidelines' cost-effectiveness limit (C/E limit) and capital recovery factors (CRF). The update to the 2011 Guidelines, Appendix G, is now available and is attached for reference. Revisions have been indicated by strikeout/underline.

Effective immediately, the C/E limit is updated to \$17,720 per weighted ton of reductions and the CRF and discount rate of one (1) percent remain unchanged compared to last year. The CRF and the updated C/E limit can be used by air districts for contracts executed beginning April 1, 2014, and must be used for any contracts executed beginning July 1, 2014.
