SUBJECT: CARL MOYER PROGRAM: REVIEW AND UPDATE OF THE COST-EFFECTIVENESS LIMIT AND CAPITAL RECOVERY FACTORS FOR 2015

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This mail-out provides an update to the 2011 Carl Moyer Program Guidelines (Guidelines) as a result of Air Resources Board direction given in Resolution 11-23 to annually update the Guidelines' cost-effectiveness limit (C/E limit) and capital recovery factors (CRF). An approved revision to the 2011 Guidelines, Appendix G, is now available and is attached for reference. Revisions have been indicated by ~~strikeout~~/underline.

Effective immediately, the C/E limit is updated to \$18,030 and the discount rate of one (1) percent increases to two (2) percent with corresponding changes in the CRF. The CRF and the updated C/E limit can be used by air districts for contracts executed beginning April 1, 2015, and must be used for any contracts executed beginning July 1, 2015.
