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# Introduction

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- Initial draft staff proposal made available late July 2003 with a workshop in October 2003
- Proposal was subsequently deferred
- Work began again in early 2004
- New draft proposal was released January 2005
- Finalized regulation and staff report out in late May/early June, with Board Hearing scheduled in July 2005



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# Main Modifications From Earlier Versions

- Higher (i.e., less stringent) emission thresholds for many component monitors in 2010-2012
- Allow either SAE J1939 or ISO 15765-4 for the OBD communication protocol
- Limit monitoring to components used by engine



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
