

Certification Requirements

- Engine manufacturer required to submit to CARB for review and approval:
 - detailed specifications for all engine diagnostics in format prescribed in regulation
 - a copy of build specs relevant to OBD compliance that are provided to engine purchasers (e.g., MIL specs and DLC specs to coach builders)
- Other powertrain system suppliers (transmission, hybrid, etc.) required to separately apply for OBD certification and submit required documentation



Enforcement

- No proposed detailed OBD enforcement test procedures at this time
 - need more experience with types of testing, number of vehicles, etc.
- However, liability for OBD noncompliances can be placed on the engine manufacturer, coach builder, or other powertrain suppliers (not just the certifying party)



Enforcement (cont.)

- Engine manufacturers liable for recall and/or fines under general ARB authority (HSC section 43105)
- Coach builders and other powertrain suppliers can be treated as “manufacturers” and thus also liable under following HSC sections:
 - Section 43105 - Recall Authority
 - Section 43211 - Penalty for Selling Non-Complying Motor Vehicles
 - Section 43153 - Sale of Uncertified Vehicles
