

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That before motorcycles of any engine family listed in the aforementioned certification plan are offered for sale, certification of the engine family's exhaust emission control systems and its hydrocarbon, or hydrocarbon plus oxides of nitrogen, designated standard as applicable in accordance with the approved certification plan and certification of the appropriate evaporative emission control system shall be required.

This Executive Order hereby supersedes Executive Order M-003-0329 dated May 2, 2001.
