IT IS ORDERED AND RESOLVED: That the following Hino Motors, Ltd. 1984 model-year diesel engines have shown compliance with the optional transient standards and are certified for use in motor vehicles with a manufacturer's gross vehicle weight rating greater than 8500 pounds:
