Relating to Certification of New Motor Vehicle Heavy-Duty Engines

CUMMINS ENGINE COMPANY, INC.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Air Resources Board by Sections 43100, 43102, and 43103 of the Health and Safety Code; and

Pursuant to the authority vested in the undersigned by Sections 39515 and 39516 of the Health and Safety Code and Executive Order G-45-3;

IT IS ORDERED AND RESOLVED: That the following Cummins Engine Company, Inc. 1986 model-year diesel-powered engines have shown compliance with the optional transient test procedure and standards and are certified for use in motor vehicles with a manufacturer's gross vehicle weight rating greater than 8500 pounds:

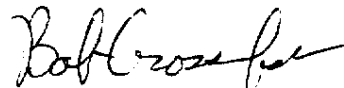
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Engines certified under this Executive Order must conform to all applicable California emission regulations.
