

How to Look Up DOORS Public Information

Introduction

The public may access DOORS information about a vehicle with an equipment identification number (EIN) or check if a company has received their annual Certificate of Reported Compliance. This user guide provides an easy step-by-step guide to finding this information.

DOORS Public Information

You may search for company compliance information here					
All vehicles subject to the in-use off-road diesel-fueled fleets regulation should be labeled with Equipment Identification Numbers (EINs) by mid-September 2009. All EINs consist of six characters - two upper case letters, one number, one upper case letter, and then two numbers (for example, "RH4M79"). The letters, I and O, and the numbers 1 and 0, are not included in EINs.					
If you suspect a vehicle you observe has a fraudulent EIN, you can look up further information on the vehicle including vehicle type, and vehicle manufacturer. Enter the EIN in the box provided. Be sure to use uppercase letters

You may enter an EIN to access the following information specific to that vehicle: vehicle type, manufacture, model, model year, and engine model year, horsepower, and if the vehicle is a two engine vehicle or not.
