Dear Mr. Natri:

The Air Resources Board (ARB) hereby submits to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) the 2007 Ventura County Air Quality Management Plan (2007 AQMP) as a revision to California's State Implementation Plan (SIP). The 2007 AQMP sets out a strategy for attaining the federal 8-hour ozone standard in the Ventura Ozone Nonattainment Area.

The Ventura County Air Pollution Control Board adopted the 2007 AQMP on May 13, 2008. ARB approved the 2007 AQMP on June 26, 2008. The 2007 AQMP addresses all federal planning requirements, demonstrates attainment of the 8-hour standard by 2013, demonstrates Reasonable Further Progress, and includes transportation conformity budgets.
