NOTICE OF CHANGE TO BOARD MEETING AGENDA REGARDING THE SOUTH COAST PM2.5 CONTINGENCY MEASURE

By notice dated January 18, 2019, the California Air Resources Board (CARB or Board) announced it would conduct a public meeting to consider the adoption of the South Coast PM2.5 Contingency Measure, which would have amended the statewide contingency measure included in the 2018 Updates to the California State Implementation Plan adopted by the Board on October 25, 2018. If adopted, CARB would have submitted the South Coast PM2.5 Contingency Measure to the United States Environmental Protection Agency as a revision to the California State Implementation Plan (SIP). The hearing was scheduled for February 21, 2019, at 9:00 a.m., at the California Environmental Protection Agency, California Air Resources Board, 1001 I Street, Byron Sher Auditorium, Sacramento, California.

PLEASE BE ADVISED that the proposed item is withdrawn and will no longer be on the calendar for the February 21, 2019, meeting. CARB is continuing to develop proposed amendments to the “2018 Updates to the California SIP” and the South Coast PM2.5 Contingency Measure to address PM2.5 requirements that will be made available for public comment in the coming months.
