NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING TO CONSIDER ASSEMBLY BILL 617 COMMUNITY AIR PROTECTION PROGRAM – SELECTION OF 2020 COMMUNITIES

The California Air Resources Board (CARB or Board) will conduct a public meeting at the date and time noted below to consider selecting additional communities under the Community Air Protection Program.

DATE: December 10, 2020

TIME: No earlier than 4:00 p.m.

Please see the public agenda which will be posted ten days before the December 10, 2020, Board Meeting for any appropriate direction regarding a possible remote-only Board Meeting. If the meeting is to be held in person, it will be held at the California Air Resources Board, Byron Sher Auditorium, 1001 I Street, Sacramento, California 95814.

The meeting of the Board will commence at 12:00 p.m., December 10, 2020, and may continue at 8:30 a.m., on December 11, 2020. The Board will consider Assembly Bill 617 Community Air Protection Program – Selection of 2020 Communities no earlier than 4:00 p.m. on December 10, 2020.

Background

In response to Assembly Bill (AB) 617 (C. Garcia, Chapter 136, Statutes 2017) the California Air Resources Board (CARB) established the Community Air Protection Program (Program). AB 617 requires CARB to annually consider selection of communities within which community air monitoring systems and/or community emissions reduction programs will be developed and implemented. Thirteen communities are currently selected for participation in the program. In September 2018, the Board selected the first ten communities. In December 2019, the Board selected three additional communities and transitioned a previously-selected, 2018 monitoring-only community into developing and implementing a community emissions reduction program.

The Board will hear staff's recommendations for selection of additional communities into the Program in 2020. CARB staff's recommendation is based on a number of factors including the Board's prior direction, community nominations received in 2020

and in prior years, lessons learned from the initial communities, and funding levels provided by the legislature for Program implementation.

CARB, as the lead agency under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), has reviewed the *2020 Community Recommendations Staff Report* and concluded that the recommendations are exempt pursuant to CEQA Guidelines §15061(b)(3) because it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the proposed action may result in significant adverse impact on the environment. A brief explanation of the basis for reaching this conclusion is included in the *2020 Community Recommendations Staff Report*.

Proposed Action

CARB staff will present the *2020 Community Recommendations Staff Report* at the meeting. The Board will take action on staff's recommendations for the selection of new communities for the deployment of air monitoring systems and/or community emissions reduction programs. Because of current travel, facility, and staffing restrictions, the California Air Resources Board's offices have limited public access.
