1	A-2-13	2015(b)	Request that military installations be included within the scope of “public agency utility” in the proposed amendments. Military installations have their own public works departments that may provide and maintain electrical infrastructure, water systems, and wastewater systems, including purchasing and utilizing traditional utility-specialized vehicles for installation maintenance and upkeep.	<p>‘ "Traditional utility-specialized vehicle" means an ICE vehicle owned and operated by a public agency utility <u>or equivalent utility system located on a military installation</u> that meets all the following criteria:</p> <p>‘ (D) Is operated at least 51 percent of the time to maintain reliable public utility services <u>or military installation utility services</u>, by a publicly owned electrical utility, as defined in Section 224.3 of the Public Utilities Code, a community water system, as defined in Section 116275 of the Health and Safety Code, Section 20200 of the Water Code, or a wastewater treatment provider, as defined in Section 116773.2 of the Health and Safety Code, <u>or an equivalent utility system located on a military installation</u>. For example, an investor-owned electric utility also owns a private community water system, only the vehicles they operate primarily to maintain the community water system would qualify under this definition; and</p>
